- Summary of TDA Workbook process
- Department Updates
- Occupancy Tax law renewed this year (every 3 years)
- Retail surveys are in progress
- Leisure Study
  - We have 10 years of data and use 5 year averages
  - 133,038 new trackable leads
  - 30,000 people sent survey, 2,900 respondents
  - Study available on <u>www.roostadk.com</u>
- Route 73 going to be paved
- Jim McKenna is not going to be on ORDA board
- GLOBAL NY will get info on ORDA venues, and conditions of venues
  - Estimate \$21 million to get venues back up to competitive state
- USA Luge debating staying here or moving to Park City
- ADK Challenge will happen this year, may be a little more expanded (July 20)
- Tupper Lake is close to contract
  - Have some existing grant work (extra \$45,000)
  - Cali Brooks contacted Jim regarding a Destination Plan for Tupper Lake, she has a grant

## VII. Regional Report

- Saranac Lake: roads in downtown in the middle of an overhaul, should be done by June 20; Hotel Saranac is coming along; old Dewdrop Inn should be sold soon
- Lake Champlain Region: TDA included 5 towns/communities working together; DMP update coming soon; Town of Ticonderoga Economic Development Committee has timeline of projects to submit to town board, which would set priorities
- Jim: Keene is grown over last few years, we'll be doing TDA with Keene/Elizabethtown/Lewis
  - Then Schroon Lake and Northern Lake Champlain Region
- Schroon Lake Region: New Executive Director, Patrick Siler; need marketing plan, can ROOST help with that? We will add it to our agenda for our next meeting in that region; Yellow Coach was sold and is being renovated
- Whiteface Region: Town has new signage which is all consistent; concerts at beach this year again; Randy Preston is looking at hamlet expansion which should help get major hotel and

waste water treatment; Memorial Highway coming along and the drainage issues are being dealt with first; new septic in castle; bridge work starts next year; gas station coming; work has begun at Mel's Diner again; there is some concern about the highway work and Bikefest; two-fly went well; Bikefest number's should be around 1000, Leadville registration is up and Uphill Registration is down (a lot of past racers have switched races); Leadville is predicting over 500 - 2nd only to The Leadville; there is a new bike shop, LeapOff

  - Possibly Diane O'Connor from the Adirondack History Center in Elizabethtown
