- What does budget change mean?
  - We needed to have any revisions approved, and moving some business in house has changed where our money should be allocated.
- Change way of business from outside to in house made salaries up and other expenses go down; overall save \$21,000 annually
- How do we increase wages, decrease outsource expenses, and they're not the same?
  - We had been over budgeting for some items
- · Saved a lot of money for Internet, which will also go down next year
- The new budget is not represented in the Financials report yet since this budget was approved this morning (October 14, 2014)
- Occupancy Tax collections
  - · August 2014 was the highest occupancy tax collections ever on our records
  - On track for the end of the year
