Self-Guided Family-Friendly Hikes

Trail	Location	Length (miles)	Description
Around the Mirror Lake	Lake Placid	2.7	Locally referred to as ATL (Around the Lake), follow the brick walkway that circumnavigates Mirror Lake on the popular 2.7 mile loop!
Brewster Peninsula Trails	Lake Placid	0.5-1.5	The Brewster Peninsula Trails are located on the shores of Lake Placid and are tucked back on a dirt road. The DEC has worked to use old access roads and selected new trails to develop this year-round destination for short, fun afternoon outings.
Heaven Hill Trails	Lake Placid	4.0	Located off Bear Cub Road, these trails have 3 main loops and all of the paths are relatively flat and accessible.
Henry's Woods	Lake Placid	0.3-2.0	Henry's Woods is a community preserve with five trails and scenic views.
Rocky Falls	Lake Placid	4.6	A gentle walk to a lovely miniature waterfall. This hike's charm is the easy route and lovely setting.
Owl's Head Mountain	Keene	1.2	Owl's Head is one of the more popular short hikes in the region due to its ease of access, outstanding views and family recreation opportunity.
Bear Den Mountain	Wilmington	2.5	Bear Den Mountain is one of those hidden peaks that gets very little attention, but should be high on everyone's list to check out. It's located above the Ausable River and is essentially part of the Whiteface Mountain Ski Area.
Baker Mountain	Saranac Lake	1.8	Also referred to as Mount Baker, this trail is one of the most popular family hikes in the region. Starting from the north end of Moody Pond, the trail is a bit steep, but rewarding.
