




## Which fishing tournament did you participate in? Check all that apply.




## How did you hear about the fishing tournament(s)? Check all that apply.




## How many times have you participated in a fishing tournament in Ticonderoga Area / Lake Champlain Region?


















# What was your estimated total expenditures for the following categories:




## Based on your experience, would you visit Ticonderoga Area / Lake Champlain Region again in the future?
