#### Saranac Lake Winter Carnival: Jan. 31-Feb. 9, 2014

Less than an hour from the Canadian border, this pretty town in New York's Adirondacks has been hosting this winterfest—with a giant homemade ice palace as its centerpiece—since 1897, when the lake supplied blocks for home iceboxes all over the region. There are winter sports contests—such as alpine and Nordic skiing, kids' skating races, and curling—as well as snow broomball, snow volleyball, snowshoeing and an all-ages ultimate Frisbee contest. This year's theme is Celtic Carnival, and festivities will include a parade and fireworks.

Visit these state parks to trim your vacation bills and avoid the summer swarms.

Cost: Free Entry

At roughly the size of Vermont, this patchwork of state and private lands makes up the country's largest state park. Another plus: It's an easy drive or Amtrak ride from most of the Northeast. Rather than heading to pricier Lake Placid, make Saranac Lake your jumping-off point; get a lake-view room at Gauthier's Saranac Lake Inn starting at \$99. Avoid the summer hiking crowd of the High Peaks region by going east to Split Rock Mountain Wild Forest, says InsidetheMap.com outdoor guide Elizabeth Lee.


