Phase Four

Arts, Entertainment, Recreation, Education




Resident Sentiment Survey

N=872






Resident Sentiment Survey (cont.)

Overall, I feel safe traveling to other neighboring communities






Resident Sentiment Survey (cont.)

Overall, I feel safe welcoming visitors back to my community






Resident Sentiment Survey (cont.) Initial Results (June 10, 2020)


