Adirondack Mountains



Planning to hike one or more of these mountains from the Adirondack Mountain Reserve?
*Your hike may require a FREE registration!

Indian Head and Fish Hawk Cliffs, Rainbow Falls, Beaver Meadow Falls, Dial, Nippletop, Bear Den, Blake, Colvin, Pinnacle, Cathedral Rocks, Bear Run, Hedgehog Mountain, Lower and Upper Wolfjaws, Armstrong, Sawteeth, Gothics, Saddleback, Basin, or Haystack.



Here's what you need to know:

Starting in 2021, visitors accessing the trails above beginning at the Adirondack Mountain Reserve (AMR) who are arriving by car, bicycle, or on foot must have a reservation.

Reservations will be open for two weeks out at a time at www.HikeAMR.org

This applies only to the trailheads that start at the Adirondack Mountain Reserve gate, not the entire park.

Hikers starting on other trailheads that cross AMR property do not need a reservation.

Reservations are required May 1 to October 31

Hikers being dropped off or arriving by bicycle must check in at the AMR Hiker Parking Lot and produce a valid reservation.

The AMR parking lot is only accessible between the hours of 5 a.m. and 7 p.m. daily, except for overnight parking.
