




## MAIN ST. RESTRICTION

### WHY RESTRICTION?

- Security is a major concern for this international event
  - 50 Different Countries
  - 2,500 Athletes and Coaches
- Desire to create a festive atmosphere on Main Street
- Mid's Park to be a daily activity focal point
  - Medals Park
- Vehicles can be used as weapons
  - Ramming incidents
  - Staging weapons/explosive devices
- Recommended by the LP23 Security Working Group
  - NYS Police, NYS Division of Homeland Security, LPPD

## MAIN ST. RESTRICTION

- January 12, 2022 January 22, 2022
- No vehicular access/hard closure from Saranac Avenue to the Grand Adirondack Hotel
- Intermittent closures/restricted access south of the Main Lot
- Vehicle access passes
- Main Lot for shuttle busses and designated delivery area
- Prescheduled windows for large deliveries and vendors
- Overnight schedule 2a-6a
- Upper NBT Lot access for limited resident/business parking and designated delivery areas
- LPCS will be closed the week of the Jan 16th (MLK)
