Lake Placid will be the "hub" of activity, with many events happening nearby. Daily medal ceremonies and a celebratory atmosphere will welcome people from around the world.

Adirondack Hub Region

[Schroon Paddle Challenge](#) This challenge encourages residents and visitors to undertake excursions on three local waterways that comprise the Schroon Lake watershed: Schroon Lake, the Schroon River to Schroon Lake, and Paradox Lake. Participants can use any type of human-powered vessel such as kayak, canoe or stand-up-paddleboard. Upon completion of the three paddles, finishers will earn the Schroon Paddle Challenge patch. Those who are able to complete all three paddles over a single weekend (Friday-Sunday) will earn an “Ultra” patch, signifying their accomplishment.
