LAKE PLACID PARKING PERMIT (LPPP)

LAKE PLACID PARKING PERMIT (LPPP) and Main Street Access Control

During the FISU World University Games in 2023, the Village of Lake Placid will restrict access requiring a special permit to Main Street between January 12, 2023, at 10:00 a.m., through January 23, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. This restricted window will be in place between the intersection of Main St and Saranac Ave to the north, and St Rt 86 and mile post marker 86-1202-1089 to the south (the southernmost driveway of the Grand Adirondack Hotel). On the southernmost portion of Main St, businesses and residents located between Mirror Lake Drive and Cummings Road, and between Parkside Drive and the Grand Adirondack Hotel will also require a permit to allow access.

Who is Eligible for the LPPP?

- Individuals who own a business within the restricted area
- Individuals who are employed by a business within the restricted area
- Individuals who live within the restricted area
- Passes are for the above mentioned only

What does the LPPP Do?

- Allows Parking in the Upper NBT lot 24/7 with access from Marcy Rd.
- Additional parking will be announced as it becomes available
- Allows access for deliveries to northern Main Street between 2:00am and 10:am
 - All Vehicles must be moved from Main St., this will ensure no vehicles will need to be towed.
 - Please be mindful of the limited space and respect the fact that everyone needs to get their deliveries in a timely manner.
 - o Lake Placid DPW will be clearing Main St. between 2am-10am.

If you use the post office to receive your mail, include the physical address of the location that they are making an application to. Addresses not located within the restricted zone will be rejected. Permits are non-transferable and revocable if abuse is discovered. Please note that the Lake Placid Post Office will be accessible without a permit.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) Who can receive a FISU 2023 parking permit? Any person who resides on Main St, owns a business on Main St., or is employed by a business located on Main St. and needs access to Main St during the FISU 2023 World University Games.
- 2) Where does this permit allow me to access and park? The permit allows access to Main St between January 12, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. and January 23, at 9:00 a.m., and allows you to park 24 hours a day during that date range at the upper NBT parking lot located off Marcy Rd during that same time period. Additional parking areas will be announced in the near future.
- 3) Does this permit allow me to park anywhere else in the village during this time frame? This permit is issued for the FISU World University Games only and should not be confused with the standard parking permit issued by the Village of Lake Placid for year-round parking access.
- 4) Is there a cost for this permit? There is no charge for the parking permit.
- 5) How will my business get deliveries during this time period? Your vendors should be contacted by the business owner and told of the open access window between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Unless the delivery can be made on foot, all vendors will have to schedule deliveries for this time period only.
- 6) When do I need to request a permit by? All permits must be requested by December 16, 2022.
- 7) **Can I still park in the NBT lot without a parking permit?** No. Anyone parking in the NBT lot must have a parking permit to park there. Those parking without a permit will be ticketed and towed away at the owner's expense.
- 8) How do I receive my permit? Permits will be mailed out after December 16th.
